The First Presidency has said, "We encourage all members worldwide to prepare for adversity in life by having a basic supply of food and water and some money in savings ... With careful planning, you can, over time, establish a home storage supply and a financial reserve." In keeping with this counsel, we will be offering a new preparedness challenge to the members of the stake.

As part of the 2014 Stake goal on strengthening families, the Plano Stake has introduced the 2014 Plano Stake Preparedness Challenge. The purpose of this challenge is to increase family and individual preparedness and within the Stake. Each family in the Plano Stake is invited to become more self-reliant and prepared by prayerfully setting and achieving certain preparedness goals in the area of Financial Preparedness, Spiritual Preparedness and Emergency Preparedness.
